This partnership with the Bird Foundation and SoftWheel is a major step in our mission of changing the dialogue. While we are currently selling wheels in North America that are both made out of aluminum and magnesium, in the coming year, we hope to offer an additional line of both metal and carbon fiber wheels.

The Crawford High Performance Family of Companies has been in the manufacturing business since the early 1980s and its members have been pioneers in composite manufacturing. We hope to maintain our commitment to excellence and innovation by continuing to develop and improve upon our sports equipment. In addition to our development of wheels for wheelchairs, our other initiatives include the design and development of an adaptive rowing seat and an adaptive kayak seat, both of which are slated to be on the market in June.
